 The meeting started with the recitation of Verses of Holy Quran by the Chairman, BoG. The Chairman, BoG welcomed the esteemed members of the Board for sparing their precious time to participate in the BoG Meeting, asking the Pro Rector to initiate the formal proceedings.

- 3. Pro-Rector, Dr. Nassar Ikram welcoming the participants, both present physically as well as on-line, initiated the formal proceedings. He briefed the participants on the key amendments made in UCP Amendment Act 2021, recently issued on 12 Jan 2022, which include the following. BoG response is also placed in front of each.
  - a. BOG has now been empowered to approve the establishment of constituent colleges, subcampuses and affiliate other educational institutions. To affiliate other educational institutions, establish constituent colleges and otherwise admit any educational institution to the University's privileges or withdraw such privileges

BoG appreciated the amendment Act and delegated the power to approve the establishment of the University's Constituent Colleges, Sub-campuses and affiliation of other educational institutions to the Chairman BoG.

 b. 20 Faculties already included in the amendment Act including Medicine, Dentistry and Allied Health Sciences; BoG empowered to approve for further addition of faculties.

BoG appreciated the amendment act and delegated the power to approve new Faculties and Departments to the Chairman. BoG further delegated the power and function of restructuring, regularization and rationalizing of the existing Faculties and Departments to the Chairman BoG.

The Chairman BOG desired that the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Allied Health Sciences, already approved under the Amendment Act be established after obtaining approval from the relevant regulatory body. The Chairman also directed to establish a Nursing School after completing all formalities.

Delegation of Powers of Board of Governors to the Chairman, Board of Governors, UCP The following Board powers, duties and functions, provided under the provisions of the University of Central Punjab Lahore Ordinance, 2002, were proposed to be delegated, under Section 13 of the Ordinance, to the Chairman, BoG:

- a. All powers/functions/ duties of the Board prescribed under Sections 2, 4, 5,10, 12, 15 and 19 of the UCP Ordinance. These powers etc. also mentioned in the working paper pertaining to the Agenda item, include:
  - Approval of affiliation of other educational institutions;
  - ii. Approval of establishment of constituent colleges, subcampuses;
  - iii. Power to appoint and remove from service any University officer/employee;
  - iv. Approval of new Faculties/Departments and reorganization, restructuring, regularization of the University's Faculties, Departments etc.;
  - Management of the University Fund, investments and Budgets;
  - vi. Power to make/repeal Regulations and Rules for the affairs of the University;
  - vii. All powers/functions/duties of the Board provided under
