Disposable Policy, extension to services

The packaging material used in canteens and cafes packaging and takeout items may include, paper and card board, polythene bags, plastic boxes and so on. Many organizations in order to promote a green culture help reduce environmental footprints pertaining to food packaging. Organizations also focus on the quality of material and the recycling of such; where reasonable efforts are towards addressing the caution of specified amount of recycled content in particular packaging for edibles.

Objectives

- 1. Be aware of several types of packaging materials and their affects on environment and humans
- 2. Reduce the use of material that takes years to photodegrade or impacts the lives of people and animals
- 3. Promote the recycling of used packaging and waste reduction efforts

UCP focuses on

- 1. There must be a cleaning department and staff working and monitoring the use of disposables and adequately putting efforts to reduce the waste on campus.
- 2. University's relevant department must put efforts to reasonably display via banners, posters, standees etc. the importance of waste reduction and promoting green environment
- 3. Ensure reasonable amount of waste bins or garbage containers must be there where importance should also be given to their proper placement. Also promote the use of dustbins or garbage containers
- 4. Decrease the use of non-degradable material harmful for soil and water species like polythene bags. Promote the use of paper cups, bags etc.
- 5. Promote the recycling of used packaging.
